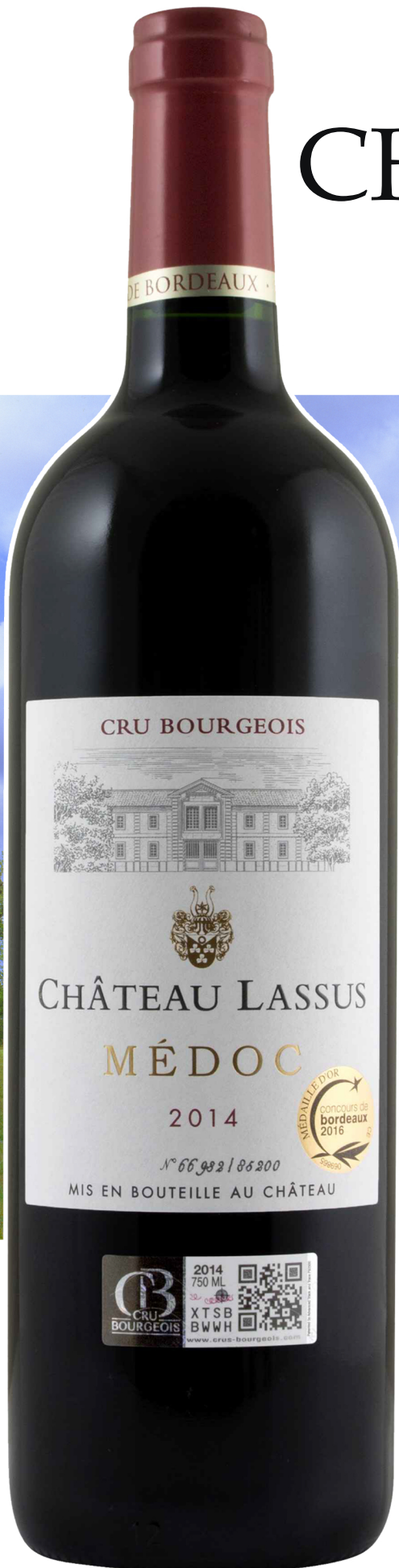


# CRU BOURGEOIS CHÂTEAU LASSUS MÉDOC

The palate is medium-bodied with grippy tannin, finely balanced with impressive backbone. Classic in style, fresh and eminently drinkable, this is an extremely fine Cru Bourgeois that should drink beautifully for several years. This is an excellent wine, natural and thoughtfully crafted.
