Château HAUT BRANDA 2018 BORDEAUX ROUGE

OVERVIEW

Family-run vineyard created in 1946 by Jean-Claude Ballet's grandfather, Cyprien Furt. Today it is Nathalie and Bruno, his great-grandchildren, who manage the whole property. Part of this property, Château Haut Branda is located in the commune of Vayres and has been taken over by the Ballet family in 1984. This family pursues the vintner tradition for four generations with passion. Nathalie and Bruno, both graduated in wine-growing and oenology, succeeded to their father, Jean-Claude, on this beautiful 57havineyard spreads on 3 properties.

VINEYARD

Soil: Chalky-clay. **Surface:** 20 hectares

Average age of the vineyard: 25 years

Grape varieties: 90% Merlot / 10% Cabernet Sauvignon

MAKING PROCESS

Classical vinification in thermo-regulated stainless steel and concrete vats. Vatting for 3 weeks.

MATCHING FOOD

Serve at 17-18°C with mixed salad of gizzard confit, stew of lamb or roasted beef tenderloin and béarnaise sauce. This wine will be perfect with a good selection of cheeses such as Brie, Livarot or Cantal.

AGEING POTENTIAL

From 5 to 10 years
